<p>The main purpose of the present course is to grasp the main features of what would be the “International Judicial Function” at the international level and to what extent it protects the general interests of the international community. Since international courts and tribunals perform different functions within the international community, the main idea is to conduct a perusal on the law governing such judicial bodies, examine some procedural issues relevant to their current function and, to the extent that it is possible, understand the influence they have in the law making processes in certain fields of International Law.
